



Final Instructions

- 1) Thank you for your entry in our McGeehan Motorsport Sunset Stages Rally.
If you are unable to compete in the event, please inform competition secretary ASAP.
If your entry was incomplete ie TBA's or any changes to Navigator, Class etc, contact Bridget on 07904018886 or via email bridie@madmc.org.
(The above info reduces queues at sign-on)
- 2) As it is anticipated that part of the event may run in darkness; crews are advised to have spotlights for your car.
- 3) Service Area (see attached map). Nutts Corner Market Area, will open at 06:00 on Saturday 4th. All vehicles must be off loaded in the designated area within the service area, and trailers parked as instructed by the Service Area manager or marshals. There is ample parking within this complex, so only one service vehicle per crew will be allowed into the service area. There will be no re-entry to service area if your service vehicle leaves.
- 4) Competitors please complete your scrutiny sheet, place door squares and HI-Vis Numbers on the car, prior to noise test, these will be supplied by MADMC.
- 5) Scrutiny will be held within the service area, commencing at 06:30 hours, scrutiny will finish at 08:30 hours.
- 6) Make your way to documentation scrutiny at the Nutts Corner Raceway Clubhouse, within 15 minutes of Mechanical Scrutiny. **All competitors must be signed on by 08:45.**
 - At documentation scrutiny your vehicle scrutiny sheet will be collected.
 - JELF Insurance Partnership will be the insuring body under Dickson & Co Brokers. Any Letters of Acceptance (if required) will be inspected.
 - Valid MSA competition Licence (Minimum National B Licence for Driver & Navigator) will be inspected.
 - Only a navigator's Licence can be applied for on the day with the appropriate fee. (valid photo required)
 - Valid Membership cards MUST be shown No card – Pay Fee.
 - Reseeding forms can only be submitted by the driver at signing-on to the competition secretary, when the car has gone through scrutiny. This must be before 7:30am. This form can be downloaded from <http://www.magherafeltmotorclub.co.uk/wp-content/uploads/2017/11/Reseeding-Request-form.pdf>
- 7) Drivers Briefing will be in the Nutts Corner Raceway Clubhouse at 09:00 hours. Important information on the operation of the stages will be explained, so **both crew members must attend**. A random draw of crew numbers will take place and any crew called, and not in attendance may result in a start being refused. Time cards will not be issued until after the drivers briefing.
- 8) Start times: Will be posted on the Official Noticeboard at Nutts Corner Raceway Clubhouse, first car away 10:01 hours, first car due to finish approximately 17:00 hours in the service area.
- 9) Litter/debris must be cleared from the service area.
- 10) The ONUS is on you (the competitor) to ensure that you are running in the CORRECT CLASS as per the entry list published. If you start the event in the incorrect class, you will be removed from the results.



- 11) All cars must carry a warning triangle, spill kit and OK/SOS Board
- 12) Reconnaissance - Competitors will be allowed to familiarize themselves with the layout of the stages only on foot or by bicycle up until 08:30.
- 13) Update of Named Officials:
MSA Safety Delegate – John Richardson, MSA Steward – William Fullerton, Assistant COC – Ian Regan, Safety Officer – John Goddard
- 14) MSA permit number for the event is: 103655
- 15) Judges of Fact - Named judges of fact will be at any split on the stages to judge that competitors follow the correct route as MSA Regulation R 29.3.3. Any competitor not completing the stage correctly, including reversing at a split will receive the stage maximum.
- 16) Tyre Warming - **ANY TYRE WARMING OR ANY ACTIVITY THAT COULD BE INTERPRETATED AS TYRE WARMING ON THE APPROACH TO STAGES 1,3,5,7 & 9** will result in the following penalties been applied.
1st offence, 1-minute penalty, 2nd offence exclusion
Excessive speed on the approach to these stages will not be tolerated with a 20MPH speed limit in force. A specific area has been provided for tyre warming at the start of these stages.
- 17) The event will be run almost entirely on sealed surfaces. A very small amount of gravel surface will be utilised in stages 2, 4 & 6.
