1.	The only Trailer Park	Meteor Electrical, 7 Corchoney Road, Cookstown. BT80 9HU Meteor's gates open at 06:45hrs. Please respect the wishes of Management at the Greenvale Hotel (due to an afternoon function), use the Trailer Park at Meteor.
2.	Scrutiny/Sign-on/ Breakfast/ Lunch	Greenvale Hotel, 57 Drum Road, Cookstown. BT80 8QS.
3.	Seeded Entries	Please check your competition number on the seeded entry list on <u>https://www.magherafeltmotorclub.co.uk/targa-rally/mtec-graphics-targa-rally/</u> or <u>facebook.com/magherafeltmc</u> Fully paid entries have been seeded, for those entries received and not paid for; they will be seeded at the back of the field on a first come first seeded basis on the day of the event.
4.	Competition numbers	WILL be provided, prior to scrutiny, place the number on the car and Open the bonnet to indicate to the scrutineers that scrutiny has yet to take place.
5.	Scrutiny/Cars	7:00am – 8:15am (Anyone not signed on by 08:30 may be excluded) Cars must be: taxed, Mot'd, Carry a warning triangle and spill kit. Have no more than four forward facing beams (R18.5.7) and carry NO advertising (R18.1.2). Note: as stated in SRs, Gravel / Offroad / Snow type tyres are not permitted. All tyres must be "E" marked.
6.	Driver/Co-Driver	Drivers must hold a full valid driving license for a car. Co-Drivers must have attained the age of 12 years and have parental/guidance consent. Drivers may only drive one vehicle once. Navigators may only navigate once.
7.	Signing on	Sign-on CLOSES at 08.30am. As this is a Clubman's Event ALL Competitors MUST be a member of MADMC, non-members must join for a fee of £10 per person.
8.	Insurance Criteria	All competitors wishing to use the scheme must comply with :

- a. I do not have the Third Party Road Section extension on my current Motor Insurance.
- b. I am aged 20 or over.
- c. I have had no more than 1 fault claim in the last three years
- d. I have no more than a maximum of 6 conviction points or a licence ban on my UK driving licence

- e. I have the appropriate competition/club membership licence as well as a UK/EU driving license and if my license is provisional I will be supervised by an adult over 25.
- f. I have no physical or mental disabilities
- g. My vehicle is MOT'd, Taxed and Insured for the road
- h. I have no other material facts to disclose
- i. Anyone aged less than 20 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their codriver be a more senior member of their family or over 25.

- 9. Drivers' Briefing: Drivers' briefing will commence sharply at 09:00am with 1st car starting @ 9:30am + car number.
- 10. Penalties: Road & test Competitors are reminded that the penalties in this event will be **strictly enforced**, there is no negotiations, as the Marshals judgement is final.
- 11. Test Diagrams/Road Book All the route information needed for the event will be provided on the morning at sign-on. Total No. of 15 tests, (5 tests x 3 times). The tests diagrams are not to scale. To do the tests correctly you MUST stop astride a line including the finish line, max. 2 non attempts to stop astride a line will result in exclusion.
- 12. Fuel Competitors are advised to have sufficient fuel to last the duration of the event, 98 miles in total. There are petrol stations on the rally route; however no provision in the road book has been made for these.
- 13. Timing With clocks set to BBC time; be advised that schedule timing is being used on this event.
- 14. Trip Please note that it is NOT essential to have a trip for the rally, your vehicle odometer will work just fine.
- 15. Refreshments Light Breakfast & lunch will be provided in The Greenvale Hotel, you will be provided with vouchers, for breakfast & lunch. No Voucher – NO FOOD.
- 16. Prize Giving/Awards Prize Giving will be held at Meteor Electrical. As stated in the S.R's, competitors who finish 1st overall will forfeit any class awards.
- 17. Marshals/Officials Ensure that all Marshals/Officials(Judges of Fact) today are treated with respect at all times throughout the event, without volunteers there would be no event!!!!
