



Final Instructions

Dear Competitor

Thank you, your entry has been accepted for the Quinn Offsite Targa Rally 2023.

In the event of you **NOT** being able to attend or have any changes to your entry please contact the Competition Secretary by text/WhatsApp on 07904018886. Changes such as Navigator/Car, Class etc. In the event of entries being accepted after the closing date, these entries will not be seeded but listed in order of receipt and will run at the back of the field.

Please keep to the specified locations, and use only the specified entrance and exits, to minimise the disruption to other customers and local residents.

1. MSA Permit No. 132922
2. **Sign-on Online** **Opens Tuesday 17th 20:00hrs & CLOSES Thursday 19th 20:00hrs**
This is via www.rallyscore.net, both driver and navigator must sign-on on the respective forms.

HQ Venue Start/Finish/Scrutiny The Elk Complex, 38-40 Hillhead Road, Toomebridge BT41 3SF.

3. Trailer Park & Offload The Elk, Toomebridge (as above)
4. Competition Numbers Entries have been seeded, please check your competition number on the seeded entry list on Rallyscore.
Competition Numbers will be provided on the morning, please ensure these are on the car before going to scrutiny.
5. Mechanical Scrutiny Will be between 07:30am and 08.30am.
Door Squares must be affixed to the car prior to Scrutiny.
6. Document Inspection Competitors must produce a RS Clubman Licence (minimum grade). Licences can be applied for from the MSUK prior to the event at: <https://www.motorsportuk.org/competitors/rs-clubman-licence/>
Licences cannot be applied for on the '**Morning of the Event**'.

Documentation Inspection & Insurance Sign-on will include:

- Collection of Scrutiny Sheet
- Checking of Licenses.

- Confirming emergency contact details.
- Issuing of membership cards.
- Signing of Insurance declarations.
- Collection of any unpaid feed.
- Issuing of Competitor Documentation i.e. Road Book & Timecards

7. Insurance Drivers wishing to use the scheme must be able to comply with REIS Declaration as below.
(If a driver cannot comply with the above criteria, please contact REIS on 0115 965 1040 ASAP)
- Automatic acceptance will be given to competitors meeting the following criteria:
- Aged 19 years or over.
 - Has held Full licence for a minimum of 6 months.
 - Has no more than 6 points on their licence.
 - Has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years.
 - The vehicle must hold a valid MOT certificate, current Road Insurance, and Road Tax unless exempt from doing so.
 - All competitors must be a named driver on the road insurance.
 - Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price, should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family, or over 25.
8. Drivers' Briefing The drivers' briefing will commence promptly at 09:30am at The Elk, Toomebridge, ALL competitors must have completed:
Rallyscore sign-on
Mechanical scrutiny & documentation inspection / insurance signing.
9. Start times The **first car** will start at 10:01am.
10. Test Diagrams All the Route information needed for the event will be provided in the competitors' road book, which will be issued from 8:00am at The Elk, Toomebridge.
11. Legal Req: Competitors are reminded that for scrutiny, cars must be: taxed, MOT'd/NCT'd, carry a warning triangle and spill kit, have no more than four forward facing beams (R18.5.7), be able to pass a sound check (R18.3.3) and carry NO advertising (R18.1.2). If your vehicle requires an MOT/NCT'd certificate please ensure that this can be presented at mechanical scrutiny along with a road tax certificate. Note: as stated in SRs, Gravel / Off - road type tyres are **not permitted**.
12. Fuel Competitors are advised to have sufficient fuel to last the duration of the event, approximately 80 miles. There are **NO PETROL STATIONS** on the rally route.
13. Timing By watches set to BBC time; be advised schedule timing is being used on this event.
14. Navigation The competitors' road book will contain locations of controls and tests, tulips for all public road sections, and diagrams and tulips for all tests. To this end, if any competitors have any questions in terms of timing, road books or test diagrams please do not hesitate to speak to one of the organising team. We will be only glad to help!
15. Trip Please note it is NOT essential to have a trip for the rally, you vehicle odometer will work just fine.
16. Tests The tests diagrams are not to scale. To do the tests correctly you stop astride a line including the finish line, max. 2 non attempts to stop astride will result in exclusion.
17. Fees Competitors are reminded ALL fees must be settled prior to the start of the Rally. Cash payments only – please note there are no ATM facilities within the Elk.

18. Refreshments Breakfast & Lunch will be provided in The Elk, Toomebridge. Each competitor will receive 2 vouchers, you must produce the correct meal voucher at breakfast / lunch.
19. Awards As stated in the SR's competitors who finish in 1st Overall, forfeit any Class awards.
20. Prize Giving Prize Giving will be in the Elk Complex at approx. 4:00pm. All trophies must be collected in person at Prize Giving and we encourage all those who have won a prize to remain in the Elk to collect their prizes. There will be food / refreshments available to purchase after the event in the Elk.
21. Named Officials **All named officials are deemed judges of fact with regards to driving manner upon entering and existing test locations**
22. Safe Driving Please respect the need for safe driving upon entering and exiting test locations as These locations are through private lanes with residents living on them, DRIVE SLOWLY (10mph with care!!)
23. If you get caught on a test, or have a problem, please move over and let the faster car through, we have a number of novices in the event and we all had to start somewhere, our aim is for everyone to have a safe and enjoyable day.
